The 3rd Sub HB 322 is much like the 1st Sub HB 322 in its financial impact on the state. Both restrict the ability of PEHP to use secure transport providers for interfacility transfers and require the use of an ambulance. This restriction would cost the state \$36,427. However, unlike the 1st Sub, the 3Rd Sub allows the Department of Health to adopt exceptions by rule. It is possible that the Department will allow an exception for PEHPs current use of secure transport, but it is not possible to know that in advance. As such, we would anticipate a cost of \$36,427 to the state based on the language of the bill.
