Typically, a network provider is not allowed to balance bill a patient when an insurer has paid a claim, except for collecting deductibles, coinsurance and copayments. In addition to these cost sharing provisions, HB 433 would allow a network provider to collect fees from a covered insured for a medical retainer agreement or concierge medical services. This may result in added costs to a patient but will not have any effect on the insurance company. As such, PEHP anticipates no fiscal impact to the State Risk Pool.
