Amwell Gets Great Reviews, Results

s you probably know, we partnered with Amwell to give PEHP members convenient access to doctors 24/7 over the phone and computer.

Through the end of 2016 there were 683 doctor visits and more than 1,800 PEHP members registered for an account. PEHP members who visited a doctor through Amwell gave the service high reviews of 4.5 out of 5.

And, doctors ratings were 4.7 out of 5. In addition, the estimated savings from these visits was over \$70,000.

The cost to use the service is only \$10 to the member for all plans; just make sure to put the service code as "PEHP" to get this pricing.

PEHP generally pays in-network preventive visits at 100%. However, you'll be billed if you get additional treatment or services at your preventive visit. An "additional service" could be something as minor as a discussion about a past or current condition. Ask your doctor how your visit will be billed; PEHP pays based on how it's billed.
