

# Diabetes Savings Program FAQ

## How do I enroll?

To enroll in Diabetes Savings Program, simply have your physician or clinician complete the [Diabetes Savings Program enrollment form](#) (enclosed and available on our website [www.pehp.org](http://www.pehp.org)) and send it to PEHP Pharmacy Services by fax or mail. You may also call PEHP Pharmacy Services for enrollment.

## How long will the program last?

Members may receive authorization for lower co-payment for one year and may re-submit for coverage in the following year. Members will need to re-enroll after one year, to continue receiving the reduced co-payment. PEHP anticipates the co-payment reduction will be available for at least two more years. Contractual changes outside of PEHP control may dictate that the program be shortened.

## Who is eligible?

The diabetes benefits are available to PEHP members who use short acting insulin, long acting insulin and/or blood glucose test strips. Once enrolled in Diabetes Savings Program, your next prescription refill for your test strips and/or insulin will be offered at the Tier-1 co-payment amount after you meet any applicable deductible.

## What is included with the Diabetes Savings Program?

- » Novolin®, Novolin 70/30®, Novolin NPH®, Novolog® and Lantus® vials only are covered at a Tier-1 co-payment after deductible.
- » FreeStyle® test strips are covered at generic co-payment after deductible.

## Are insulin pens covered under the Diabetes Savings Program?

Unfortunately, Novolog FlexPens® and Lantus Solostar Pens® are not eligible for a reduced co-payment; however they will remain covered at the regular 2nd tier (Preferred) co-payment after any applicable deductible.

## What if I don't use a FreeStyle® glucose monitor now?

Non FreeStyle® users will receive a new blood glucose monitor free of charge in association with this change. ## Where can I receive a reduced co-payment?

After enrolling in the Diabetes Savings Program, PEHP will authorize you to obtain up to a 30-day supply at a retail pharmacy. Reduced co-payments are not available through mail order/90-day supply. However, you may obtain a 90-day supply of Novolog®, Novolin R®, Novolin 70/30® or Novolin NPH®, Lantus® and FreeStyle® test strips at your regular 2nd tier (Preferred) co-payment through mail order. You cannot get a 90-day supply for a \$10 co-payment.
